Bursaries at Monkton

We are able to offer a variety of bursaries according to circumstance and level of need:

Transformational bursaries are life-changing bursaries, designed to help those most in need. Often providing recipients with a safe place away from challenging circumstances, these bursaries aim to fully support students throughout their time at Monkton (for example, we currently support three pupils from war-form countries).

Springboard Bursaries: We partner with the Royal Springboard Foundation (RSF) to offer a fullyfunded boarding place to at least one disadvantaged pupil per year. Moniton works closely with RSF to find a surell that will thrive within our learning environment.

Christian Leadenship Bursaries provide Sixth Form places for young people from missionary and dengy farifies, who would benefit from the exceptional pasteral and academic support offered at our school (for one of our current CLB students, Monitote provides them with the opportunity to assimilate back into life in the UK after lifering abroad, before heading to University).

General bursaries are available to support families who would not otherwise be able to afford to send their children to Monkton. All bursaries are means tested and reviewed annually.

The Hardship Fund ensures that all pupils have a holistic, fulfilling experience through receiving extra support for field trips, uniforms and pursuit of personal interests to name a few.

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Since our foundation, Monkton has supported children from war-torn countries, missionary families and from challenging social or economic backgrounds. We offer a safe place for these children to thrive, whilst creating a diverse and vibrant school community that enables them to thrive.

Monitor Thinks Differently, Our aim is to inspire young people to become consequence, kind an admittious adduct who live Milling Buese. We do this through a proactive pastoral appraach, rooted within the Christian faith. For many of our papies this has transformative benefits, for some this is only possible through the support of a barrany. It is through the generous support of our Moniton community that we can provide these life-tranging barranese.

This year, we are supporting students on full bursaries, and many more through our wider bunsarial support. Thanks to the generosity of our Monkton community, this number has been able to grow from just 2 pupils in 2016.
